

# All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) 2018

## OVERVIEW

### The Programme

The All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) is conducted for admission into the National Law University, Delhi. Students who pass the AILET are eligible to pursue an undergraduate B.A. L.L.B. (Hons.), an L.L.M. or a Ph.D. programme. There are 80 seats available for the B.A. L.L.B. course.

## REQUIREMENTS

### Eligibility

Following are the eligibility criteria for appearing for the AILET –

1. Candidates must have passed their 10+2 qualifying examination with a minimum aggregate of 50%.
2. Students appearing for the qualifying examination in May/April may also apply. However, they will have to provide evidence of passing with the required marks at the time of admission.
3. There is no age limit or other criteria for the AILET.

## ADDITIONAL DETAILS

### Important information

1. The AILET will be conducted in an offline mode and will consist of 150 multiple-choice objective questions. The length of the examination will be 1 hour and 30 minutes.
2. The paper will consist of 5 subjects - English, General Knowledge, Basic Mathematics, Legal Aptitude and Reasoning.
